


Activists launched 656 campaigns during full year 2024, down 26% compared to full year 2023

**Microsoft Corp** is the largest target of activists during 2024

John Chevedden led all other activists by 58 campaigns launched during full year 2024

Financial firms were the most targeted sector during this period with 126 campaigns

Demands for shareholder rights and board representation account for 82% of activist demands

Goldman Sachs led all financial advisors by number of campaigns with 57 during full year 2024
